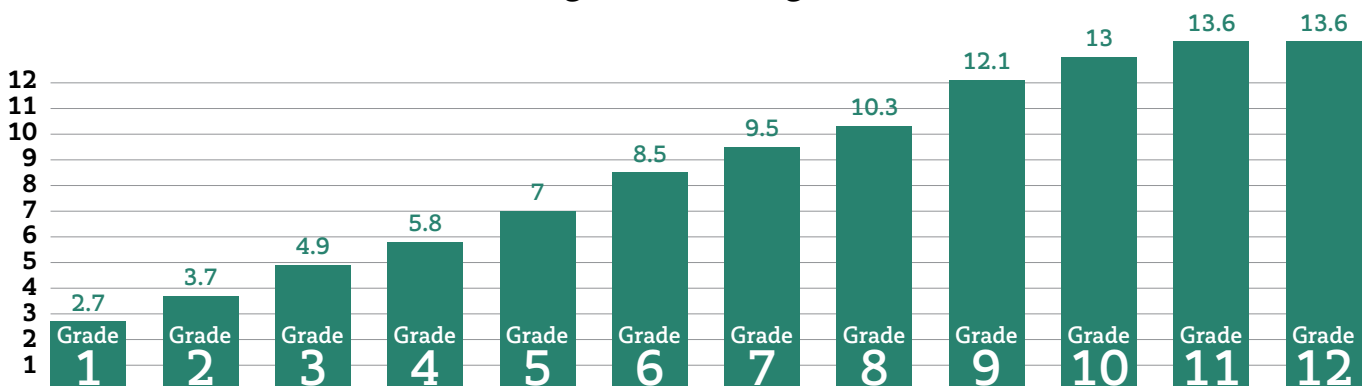

We are creating new cover designs for most LightUnits as courses are reprinted. The content has not changed. Your order may include some LightUnits with legacy covers and some with the new look. Teacher's Guide and Answer Key covers will also be updated over several years.

GETTING TO KNOW *Our Format*

What is a LightUnit?

A LightUnit is a consumable workbook that includes exercises, quizzes, and a test. Ten LightUnits equal a one-credit course; five LightUnits equal a half-credit course.

Each LightUnit contains fifteen to seventeen days of work. Before issuing a LightUnit to the student, remove the test from the center and the quizzes from the back of the book.

What are different course formats?

LightUnit-based courses

In LightUnit-based courses, the LightUnits include the lesson text. No reader or textbook is required.

Textbook or reader-based courses

Some courses require a textbook or reader. The consumable study materials vary:

- **Study Guide LightUnits** accompany a textbook or reader and provide exercises, quizzes, and tests.
- **Worksheets** are an alternative to Study Guide LightUnits for selected courses in Social Studies and Literature. They are designed for classrooms where teachers are more actively involved in providing guidance, instruction, and review. There are two sets of worksheets per course. Quizzes, reviews, and tests come in a separate pack.

Variations

Math Grades 4-9 offer the option of either a LightUnit-based or a textbook-based course. Consumable student materials for the textbook-based courses provide drills, graphs, quizzes, and tests.

We also offer some courses from other publishers. These courses use the format developed by the publisher.

What is Sunrise Edition?

Most Christian Light courses are in Sunrise Edition format, which features daily lessons, review sections, two quizzes, and a test. (See page 10 for more information.) Some courses have been revised as Sunrise 2nd Edition.

A few older Christian Light courses are not yet available in Sunrise Edition: Bible 10-12, Science 7-9, 11 and 12, and Social Studies 12. In these non-Sunrise LightUnits, material is presented in sections rather than lessons. Each section ends at a Self Check, which is similar to a quiz.

What is included in Teacher's Guides?

The content of Teacher's Guides varies but typically includes review questions, instructions for teaching new concepts, and appendixes with scope and sequences and alternate LightUnit tests. Lesson plans in lower-grade Teacher's Guides are more detailed than those in higher grades. Many Teacher's Guides contain student pages with the answers filled in (math Teacher's Guides include solutions).

Do I need to buy Answer Keys?

If you purchase a Teacher's Guide that includes answers, you do not need to purchase a separate Answer Key unless you want students to score their own work. To determine if a Teacher's Guide has answers, check the course description or refer to the chart on page 11.

How It Works

Sunrise Edition curriculum uses a spiral learning method. Here is how it works to make learning easier for students:

Incremental teaching. In language arts, math, and reading, new material is introduced in small steps, making the learning process less overwhelming and more efficient.

Students' daily work is based on a 30-to-70 ratio, with approximately 30 percent of the exercises being new material and 70 percent being review material. The "learning thread" on a particular concept is simple in the beginning and expanded in later lessons so that learning is cumulative.

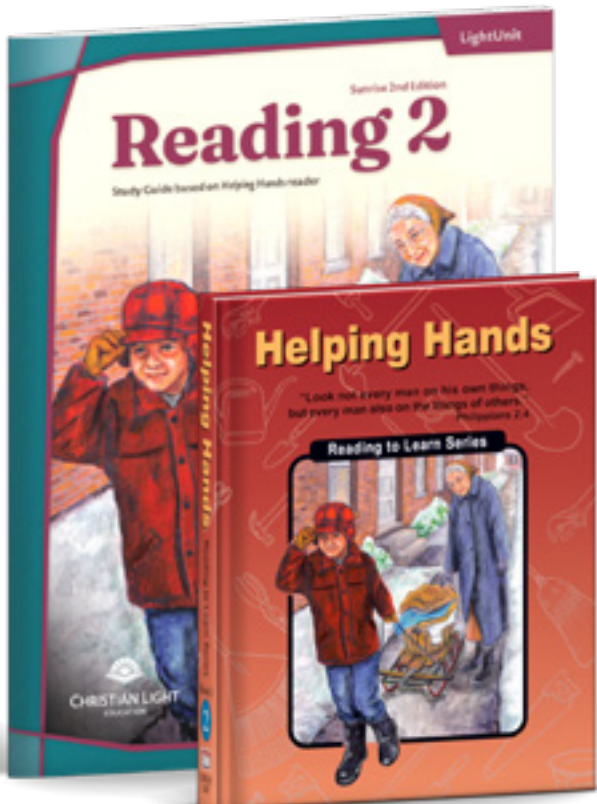
Picture a train winding up and around a mountain. For example, the fraction train starts in Grade 1 with cars carrying a light load of simple fractions. As the train winds up and around the track, it pauses at stations, filling the cars that were partially filled with more difficult concepts about fractions and adding new cars carrying small loads of new concepts. The train chugs to the top a few years later with cars filled with facts and concepts.

Systematic continuous review. Part of the incremental approach is a system of continuous, comprehensive review. After a concept is introduced, students review it multiple times through exercises in following lessons. Students gain mastery by continually reviewing concepts.

Reading well is an essential life skill. In addition to fostering a lifelong love of reading, Christian Light's Reading program helps students develop the reading and analytical thinking skills they need in today's world. With a foundation of good stories and poems, the curriculum emphasizes vocabulary, comprehension, and literary elements, techniques, and genres.



Overview

Christian Light Reading begins with Learning to Read, our comprehensive phonics-based reading program (pages 28 & 29). Phonics continues in Language Arts 1 & 2. After Learning to Read, first-grade students are ready to begin with the reader *I Wonder* in Reading 1. Reading 1 focuses on comprehension and oral reading with limited phonics review.

Grades 2 & 3 each have ten LightUnits to accompany their hardcover readers. Teacher's Guides contain aids to teaching and are integral to Grades 1-3.

Grades 4-8 consist of one reader and five LightUnits per grade. This lighter workload allows more subjects to be studied while still honing reading comprehension and literary analysis.

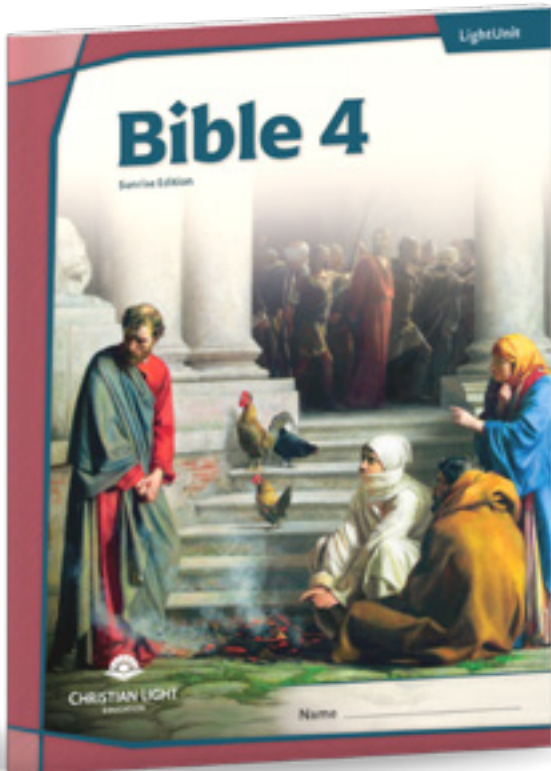

The goal of our Bible program is to point students to Jesus Christ, strengthen their love for the Word, and deepen their desire to surrender their hearts in devotion to Him. Students will gain a thorough knowledge of Bible facts and increase their understanding of and appreciation for God's timeless principles.



Overview

In the lower levels, Christian Light Bible teaches Bible stories in chronological order, introducing simple truths along with Bible history, geography, and cultures of the Old and New Testaments.

Sunrise Bible is available in Grades 1-9, but is an optional subject in the first two grades. There are no quizzes or tests in Grades 1 & 2, giving students the opportunity to develop a positive attitude toward Bible learning without pressure. Grades 3-9 follow the Sunrise format of lessons, quizzes, and a final test.

The Bible stories in elementary levels are retold in fresh, readable language that brings the Bible to life for students. Realistic pencil drawings illustrate most stories.

Grades 10-12 are being developed to fit the Sunrise model. Until then, these grade levels consist of ten self-study LightUnits. A day's work consists of selected Bible readings and corresponding exercises.

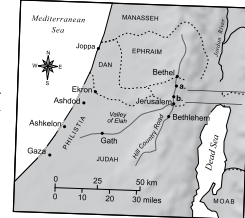

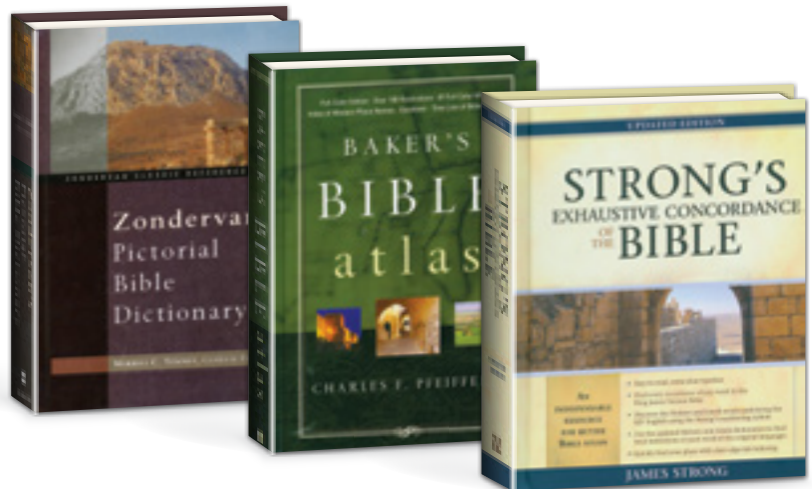

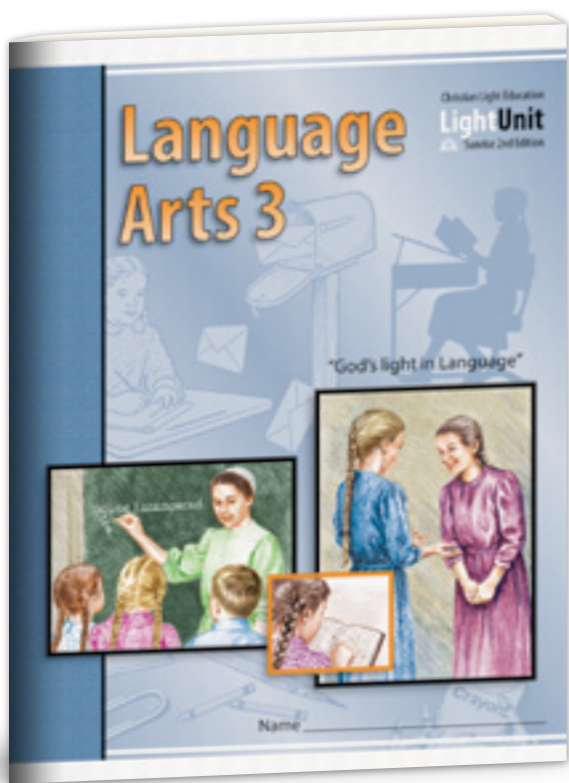

The Language Arts program lays a solid foundation for an essential life skill: communicating with clarity and purpose. Grammar, spelling, handwriting, and study skills form a framework that supports students in becoming strong writers, confident speakers, capable researchers, and lifelong learners who practice positive, wise communication.



Overview

Grades 1 and 2 Language Arts are required to complete our phonics program begun in Learning to Read, but can also be used with any phonics-based learning-to-read program.

In Language Arts, students study grammar, language mechanics, and the use of resource books, while also becoming adept at researching and writing. Each day a new concept is introduced in a small easily mastered increment. A review section covers a variety of old and new increments to ensure mastery. The lesson ends with penmanship and spelling practice so that you do not need a separate spelling program.

Creative writing assignments are also included.

Perspectives of Life in Literature and Perspectives of Truth in Literature challenge high school students with selections from Bunyan, Frost, Hawthorne, and others (page 53).

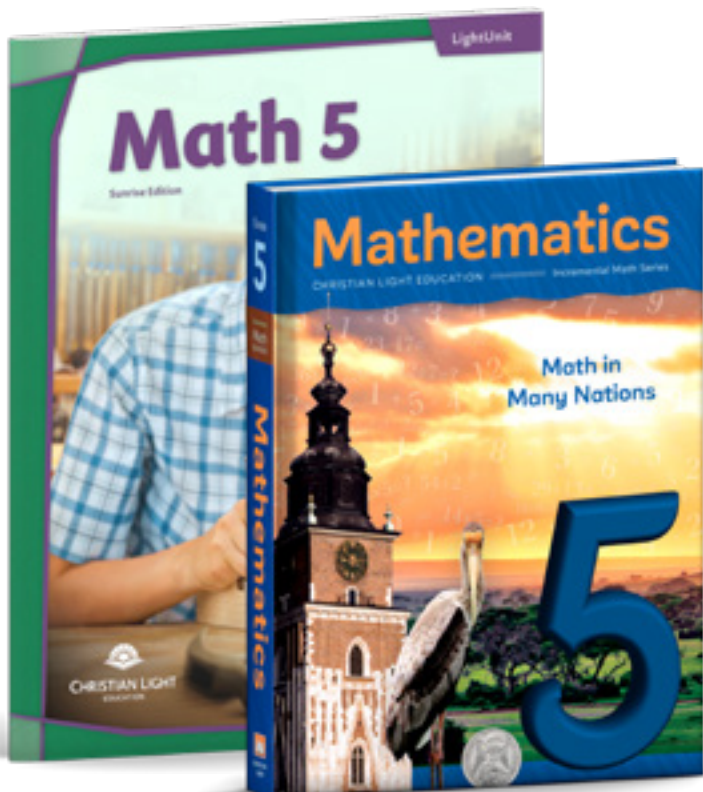

Sunrise Math takes a systematic approach to learning. New concepts are introduced in small increments, followed by comprehensive daily review. Story problems and exercise themes promote Biblical values in finances, in family living, and in our understanding of the created world.



Overview

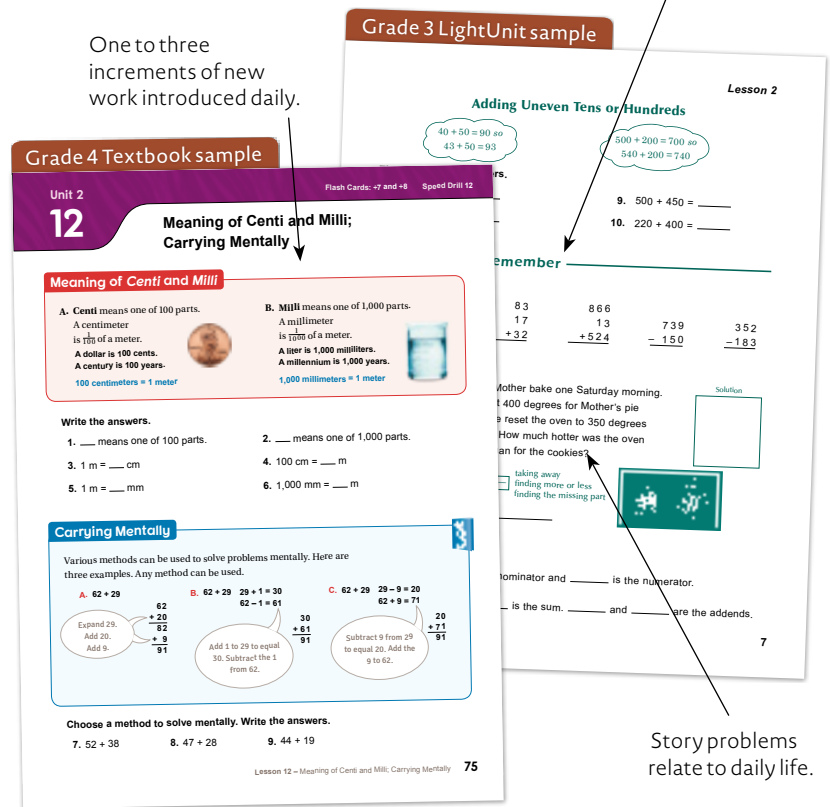
Memorizing number facts is emphasized in the first four grades, using daily oral exercises, speed drills, and Christian Light’s built-in flash-card system. Basic geometry, money, problem solving, mental math, and number patterns are introduced.

In Grades 4 and 5, basic algebra concepts are incorporated along with more complex arithmetic skills such as long division, decimals, and fractions. Grades 7 and 8 concentrate on consumer math, geometry, and pre-algebra.

In high school, Algebra 1 and Algebra 2 are available in Sunrise Edition.

Two options are available in Grades 4-9. Choose either the LightUnit or textbook format.

Mixed review keeps previously learned concepts fresh.

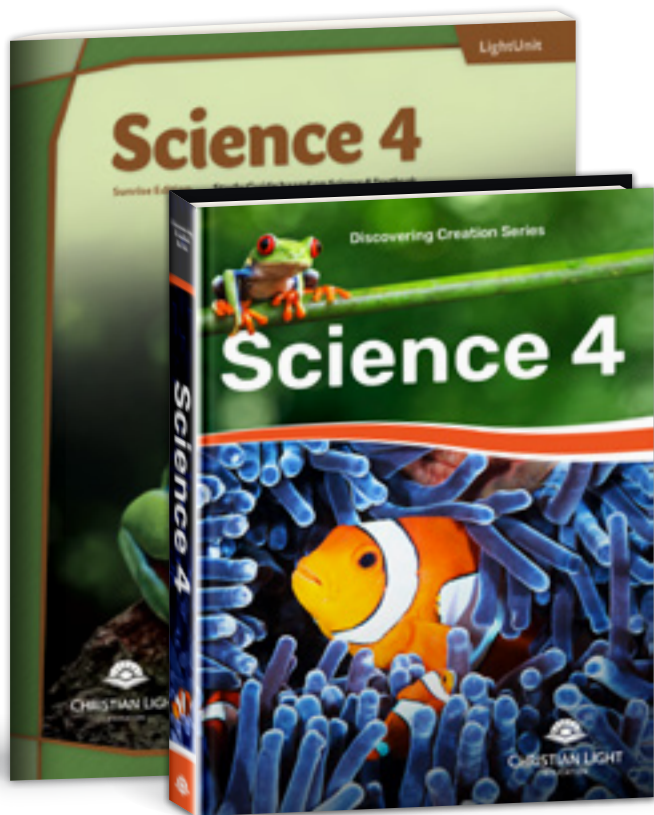

The study of the natural world and how things work is never complete without recognition of the awesome Creator who designed it all, from the intricacies of the atom to the infinity of space.



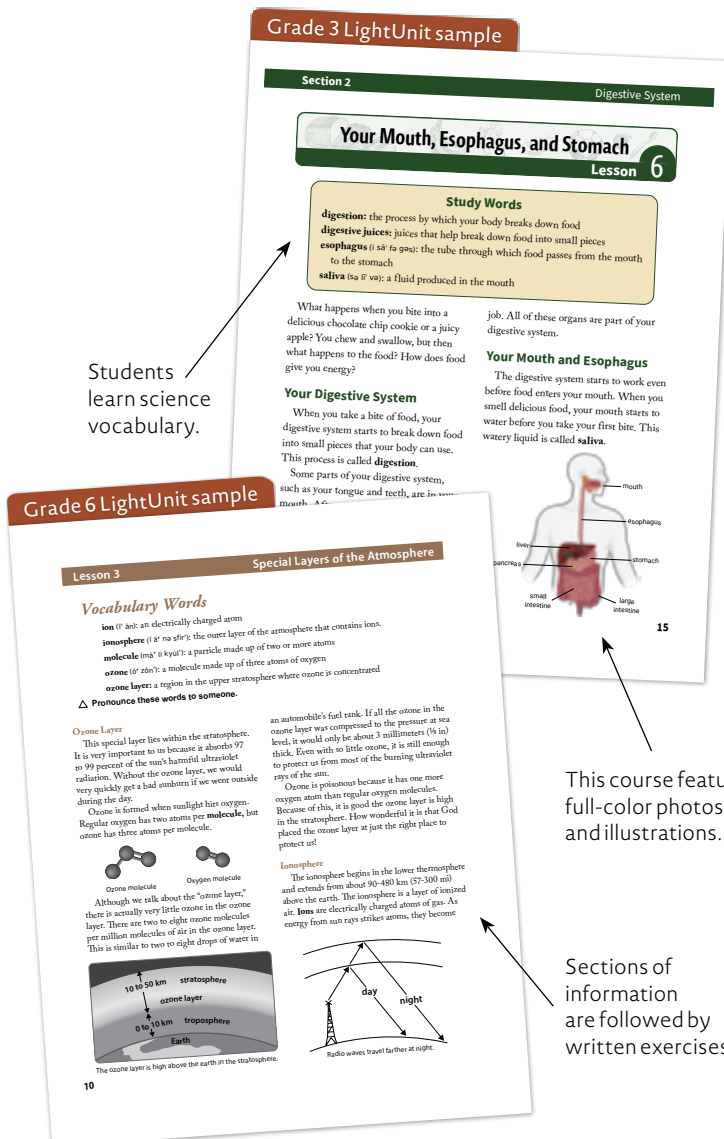
Overview

In elementary grades, Christian Light Science uses simple experiments along with workbook exercises to help students explore and learn scientific laws. Health studies are incorporated into Science. Science supplies for experiments are available from Home Science Tools®.

Grades 1-6 and high school biology are available in Christian Light's Sunrise Edition format. All other grades are in the older format where the daily exercises are not divided into lessons and review is limited. Science is considered a supplemental course for Grades 1 and 2.

Grades 4, 5, and high school biology are based on a textbook. The other grades are LightUnit-based.

High school courses include general science, biology, chemistry, and physics. We offer some Apologia and Berean Builders courses as alternatives to our own while new Christian Light courses are being developed.

How Learning to Read works

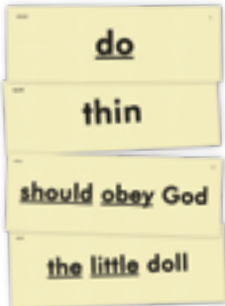
Each sound is introduced with a letter card followed by a story focusing on the picture and new sound. For example, for the t sound, the story of children discovering a turtle with a house that “just fits” captures the child’s attention and motivates him to learn the sound.

The story ends with a fun rhyme to connect the sound with the letter—“/t, t, t, t/ Turtle Tim takes his house on top of him.”

Learning and repeating the rhyme rivets the combination in the child’s mind. Questions about the story help develop comprehension. The new sound is further reinforced in the LightUnits with a variety of activities—coloring, writing, listening for the new sound, oral drill, and spelling.

Graduation Requirements



**CHRISTIAN LIGHT
ACADEMY**

When enrolled in Christian Light Academy, students can choose between three different diploma tracks to accommodate their interests, academic abilities, and vocational plans. The credit requirements for each course of study are given in the chart below.

This chart reflects the minimum standard for a Christian Light diploma. Additional credits may be desirable for meeting your personal goals or the requirements of your state or province.

Academic Diploma

The Academic diploma is recommended for students who are academically capable or who plan to go to college. All courses must be high school level, and a foreign language credit and physical education credit are required.

General Diploma

The General diploma does not require a foreign language credit and allows some eighth-grade courses to count for credit if they are completed in high school.

Vocational Diploma

The Vocational diploma accommodates students who struggle academically. This level does not require a foreign language or physical education credit and allows credit for some elementary courses if they are completed in high school.

Graduation Requirements for a High School Diploma

Students receive high school credits when entering their ninth year of school or when beginning work in ninth grade material, whichever comes first. One credit = 10 LightUnits, or in some cases, 120 hours of classroom work, or 240 hours of laboratory-type activity.
